#### FIRST AID:

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**Application Rate:** Apply at 250 to 300 kilograms per hectare.

**Shrubs and Evergreens:** Sprinkle 24.84 grams evenly around dripline and work into top 0.025 meters of soil.

**Trees:** Apply 0.23 kilograms per 0.025 meters of trunk diameter. Distribute evenly under branches to dripline.

Apply to dry turf or foliage and irrigate thoroughly immediately after application. Iron and other plants nutrients can cause staining of sidewalks. Sweep walkways prior to irrigation. Walkways should be dry at time of application. Keep away from pools, ponds, etc. Do not contaminate potable water. Do not apply with a drop-type spreader. The grinding action of these spreaders destroys the coating of the urea and will increase burn potential.

**SPREADER SETTINGS:** These suggested spreader settings are not intended to replace your normal calibrations. Calibrate your spreader before applying product.
