Characteristics and areas of use

Arena II is a medium fine, dark green turf perennial ryegrass that has exceptional year round growth characteristics for a dark type. The year round growth makes it an ideal choice for hard wearing situations such as golf tees, fairways, sportsfields, tennis courts or anywhere that a hard wearing dark coloured turfgrass is required.

Breeding history

Arena II was bred in New Zealand and Australia from elite germplasm that was screened for year round growth, disease resistance and hard wearing turf characteristics. Arena II has a high endophyte level that helps to protect against insect feeding.

Sowing rate

Arena II perennial ryegrass can be sown in lawns at 2 - 4 kg/100m². Use the higher seeding rate for faster establishment. In new sportsfields and winter overseeded couchgrass it should be sown at 400 – 500 kg/ha
